#### **Live Safely with Wildfire**



#### Our Fire-Prone Ecosystem

Montana forests experienced wildfires historically. Many forests at low elevations had frequent, lowintensity wildfires that created open forests dominated by large, widely spaced trees with grass understories. Due to factors fire suppression, land management practices, and climate today's forests often contain dense trees, downed fuels, and many small

trees and shrubs. As a result, fires can burn intensely. Fires behavior is determined by fuel, weather, and topography. Of these, you can only influence the **fuels**! The objective is to treat fuels so that when a wildfire burns, it is less severe and can be more easily suppressed.
